
**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK AT THE
INTERSECTION OF IOWA HIGHWAY 10 AND AVENUE H, HAWARDEN,
IOWA**

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 321.255 and Section 61.04 of the Hawarden Municipal Code authorize the Hawarden City Council to designate and maintain crosswalks at intersections where due to traffic conditions there is particular danger to pedestrians crossing the street and at such other places as traffic conditions require; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that the intersection of Highway 10 and Avenue H is one such place where traffic conditions and pedestrian foot traffic present a particular danger;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the City Council of Hawarden, Iowa that the City designates a pedestrian crosswalk running North and South across Iowa Highway 10 where it intersects with Avenue H in Hawarden and authorizes the maintenance of the same with any appropriate traffic controls as deemed necessary by the City Administrator and Chief of Police in conformance with all applicable state and federal laws rules and regulations.
