Job Summary: Performs routine, skilled, manual, and maintenance work with city streets, alleys, vehicles,

equipment, buildings, grounds, and parks.

Essential Functions

1. Mows and trims grass on right of ways and parks; sprays for weeds and fertilizers; plants, trims, and removes trees and shrubs as needed.

- 2. Maintains and repairs streets and alleys including patching potholes and cracks, laying gravel, grading, and sweeping. Paints curbs and road markings.
- 3. Plows and shovels snow from City streets. Applies sand as needed.
- **4.** Cleans and maintains curb, gutter, and storm sewer systems.
- 5. Maintains street signs.
- **6.** Builds and repairs concrete as necessary.
- **7.** Performs miscellaneous cleaning, maintenance, and repair work on City-owned buildings including park facilities, equipment, and shelters.
- **8.** Completes service and maintenance of City vehicles and equipment.
- 9. Attends meetings and seminars to remain current on new information relating to all aspects of the job.
- **10.** Cleans and Jets sewer distribution system as needed.
- 11. Remove dead trees from ROW's and all city owned facilities.
- **12.** Ability to establish and maintain effective work and employee relationships within the department, other departments of the City and the public.
- **13.** Other duties as assigned in other departments.
